Districting Criteria

Required:

- Relatively equal in population
- In compliance with the Federal Voting Rights Act

Recommended:

- Contiguous
- Easily identifiable and understandable lines, following city, natural, and man-made boundaries
- Keep districts compact appearance/function

Sequencing of Election Districts

Sequencing determines when each district is up for election, and then residents will vote in those districts every four years thereafter. Two districts will be scheduled for 2024 and three districts will be scheduled for 2026.

How to determine sequencing:

- Hear input from the public, if any
- Staff will create a proposed sequencing schedule in a way that will be least disruptive to the natural election cycle.


Districting Timeline

- June 6, 2023 Public Hearing #1: Districting 101
- August 1, 2023Public Hearing #2: Community Outreach
- September 5, 2023 Public Hearing #3: Draft Maps
- September 19, 2023 Public Hearing #4: Draft Maps
- October 3, 2023 Public Hearing #5: Final Vote
